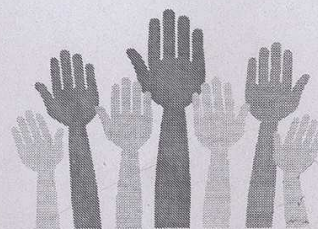

31. Briefly explain your reasons for applying to become a ISC Volunteer:			



As we all aware that Sericulture is a land-based activity with good potential for generating productive rural employment. It has several advantages such as labour intensive nature, low capital investment, short gestation period, and good market.

I have been in Sericulture Industry for the past 30 years since 1984. I had come across various problems faced by the sericulture industry and remedial measures taken up by the concerned Sericulture Departments including Central Silk Board. The Indian as well other silk producing countries are currently facing several problems which have restricted full utilization of its potential. Though the Indian breeds have the potential to produce the good quality of bivoltine silk, the problem arises due to lack of:

- ❖ sufficient thrust on the adoption of improved technologies;
- ❖ strict disease control measures;
- ❖ quality leaf due to insufficient inputs to mulberry garden;
- ❖ Importance of rearing of young age silkworms
- ❖ Usage of appropriate cocoon mountages;
- ❖ grading system for cocoons & quality-based pricing system.

The producer organizations like India, Indonesia, Thailand, North Korea, Uzbekistan, Vietnam & Brazil etc., are still weak and not having strong cooperation from international organizations, the coordination between sericulture and other sectors such as forestry, health and environment is poor to be additionally supported by the government, NGOs and private sector.

In this context, It is necessary to formulate effective country /state /region specific policies for promotion of sericulture industry in the countries/regions.
